The individual must have strong written and verbal communication skills with demonstrated ability to conduct effective presentations, prepare written reports and documents, and ability to plan and manage projects with full responsibility. Under general direction, the Associate Engineer performs a wide variety of complex engineering duties involving the design and construction of new systems. Previous experience with dam safety improvements projects, knowledge of permitting and federal regulatory work, and geotechnical engineering principles are highly desirable. The preferred candidate has the ability to interact with consulting design teams and manage and administer design and construction projects. This position requires a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major course work in civil engineering or related field is required. Possession of the State of California registration as a Professional Civil Engineer is required. Possession of, or the ability to obtain a valid California Driver's License by time of appointment is necessary.
