**3. Santa Paula Basin Activities (Lindquist) (5 minutes)**

Staff will present a summary of recent activity regarding the safe yield study, actions by the TAC, and the TAC-Working Group.

**4. Groundwater Tracer Study (Lindquist) (5 minutes)**

Staff will present an update of the tracer study being designed for implementation in the Saticoy/Noble spreading basins.

**5. Groundwater Model Development Update (Sun/Lindquist) (5 minutes)**

Staff will present an update on activities associated with the groundwater model development.

**6. Groundwater Production Reporting (Morgan) (20 minutes)**

Staff will initiate a discussion of how, or if, the District should consider requiring automated meter reading for all groundwater production wells. This discussion will also touch on the issue of non-reporters.

**7. Proposed El Rio Iron and Manganese Water Treatment Facility (Detmer) (5 minutes)**

An iron and manganese water treatment plant is proposed for construction at the El Rio facility. As currently envisioned, groundwater from the Lower Aquifer System would be extracted on a 24/7 basis. Staff will summarize the planned efforts to evaluate the impact of this groundwater pumping on water levels.
