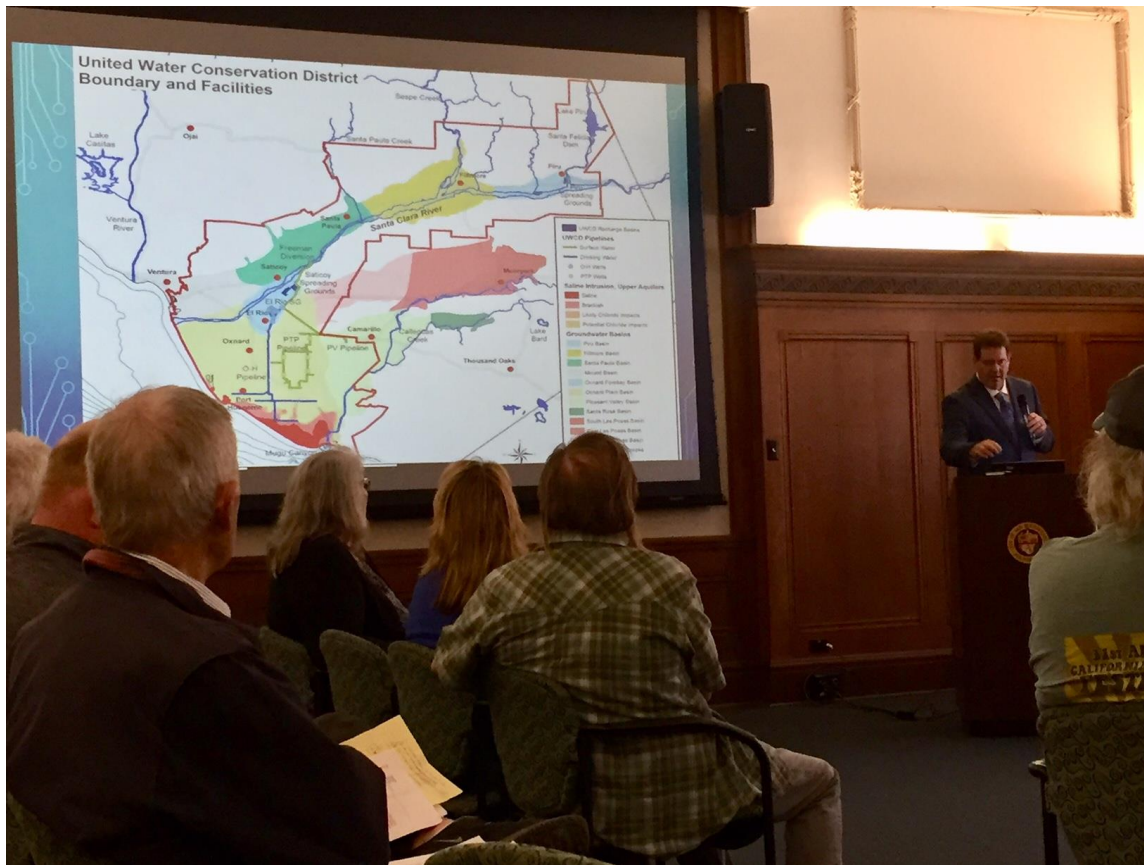


United Board President and General Manager Present to City of Ventura's Water Commission

United Water Conservation District Board President Robert Eranio and General Manager Mauricio Guardado kicked off the May 22 meeting of the City of Ventura's Water Commission meeting with a presentation to the seven commissioners and members of the general public at Ventura City Hall. The presentation was aimed at providing the committee with a better idea of United's operations and how its efforts benefit the City of Ventura.

The tag team presentation included relevant historical information as well as an overview of United's current and future projects that have or will have a positive impact on the region's water resources. Over half of the City's water resources, including aquifers in the Mound Basin, Oxnard Plain and Santa Paula, rely on groundwater recharge provided by United Water Conservation District.

Eranio and Guardado also shared information regarding the need for expansion of Ventura County's State water participation, including the formation of more partnerships, the pooling of resources to purchase more State water, and also the value of building necessary infrastructure projects.
