United Water Conservation District has scheduled a pipeline shutdown affecting the turnouts listed in table below to replace two 42- inch and one 24-inch diameter isolation valves that no longer function as they were originally designed. The shutdown will affect the service area from Central Ave. to the intersection of Wolff Rd. and Sturgis Rd. See sections #1-5 on Fig.1.

The replacement of these valves is critical to preventing potential widespread shutdowns in the future. When complete, this project will allow for smaller sections of pipeline to be isolated, thereby affecting fewer users resulting in decreased future isolation times when performing maintenance activities.
