

United Water Conservation District is a special district that was founded in 1927. The District is responsible for the management, conservation, and enhancement of the water resources of the Santa Clara River Valley and the Oxnard Coastal Plain in Ventura County. District facilities include Santa Felicia Dam, Freeman Diversion facility, groundwater recharge basins, well fields, water treatment facilities and major transmission pipelines.

SUMMARY

The work of the District's Environmental Services Department centers on supporting the District's efforts to achieve its mission to manage, protect, conserve and enhance the region's water supply in an environmentally balanced manner. The Environmental Services Manager provides strategic and day-to-day direction and oversight of the District's environmental initiatives and functions, including participation in management and planning of District operations and projects to ensure regulatory compliance and long-term sustainability of District water resources programs.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILIITES

Reporting to the Chief Engineer, the Environmental Services Manager position has full supervisory responsibility for positions within the Environmental Services Department, including full-time exempt positions, full-time nonexempt positions, and several part-time seasonal positions.
