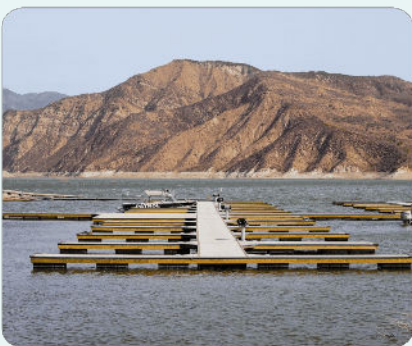
## Refreshed Marina at Lake Piru Offers A More Streamlined Boating Experience

Overnight campers can now dock their boats for the entire weekend thanks to the newly renovated marina!

Campers and day trip boaters will also be able to leave their boats while they visit Condor Point Store or grab a quick bite to eat.

"Lake Piru is a recreation destination, and we're constantly seeking ways to enhance the experience for visitors exploring the area," Lake Piru's Senior Park Ranger Bernard Riedel Jr. said. "We are thrilled to have our marina back in top condition after the storm damage earlier this year."

The marina offers 66 slips in addition to the courtesy docks that previously only allowed for short-term stops. Boaters can now pull in and offload at the marina for day use or even dock their boats for the duration of their stay for a \$10 overnight fee.



Taking two months to build and launch, this smoother docking process is part of United Water Conservation District's efforts to improve Lake Piru's amenities. The marina restores boating choices at Lake Piru, along with a long list of recreation opportunities such as lakeside picnicking, camping, fishing, water sports, and short-term docking options.

In the future, UWCD is looking to install boat and kayak rentals along the marina for even more exciting experiences at Lake Piru.

This marina is the latest investment in Lake Piru, increasing community value in this vital escape from city life. The marina joins plans for upgrading the Lake Piru Recreation Area, including 236 campsites with full water and sewer hookups. Visitors can look forward to a future Recreation Area with cost-effective enhancements that prioritize safety and comfort above all.
