Groundwater Quality – Nitrates in Forebay

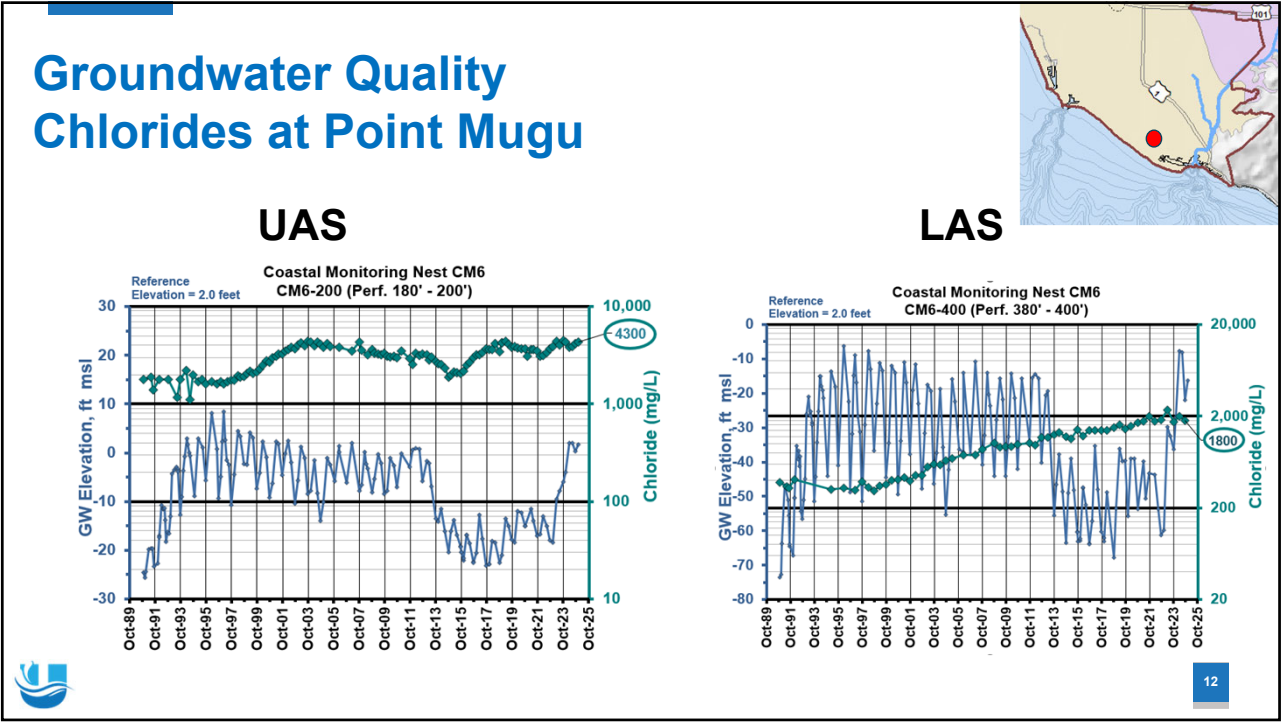
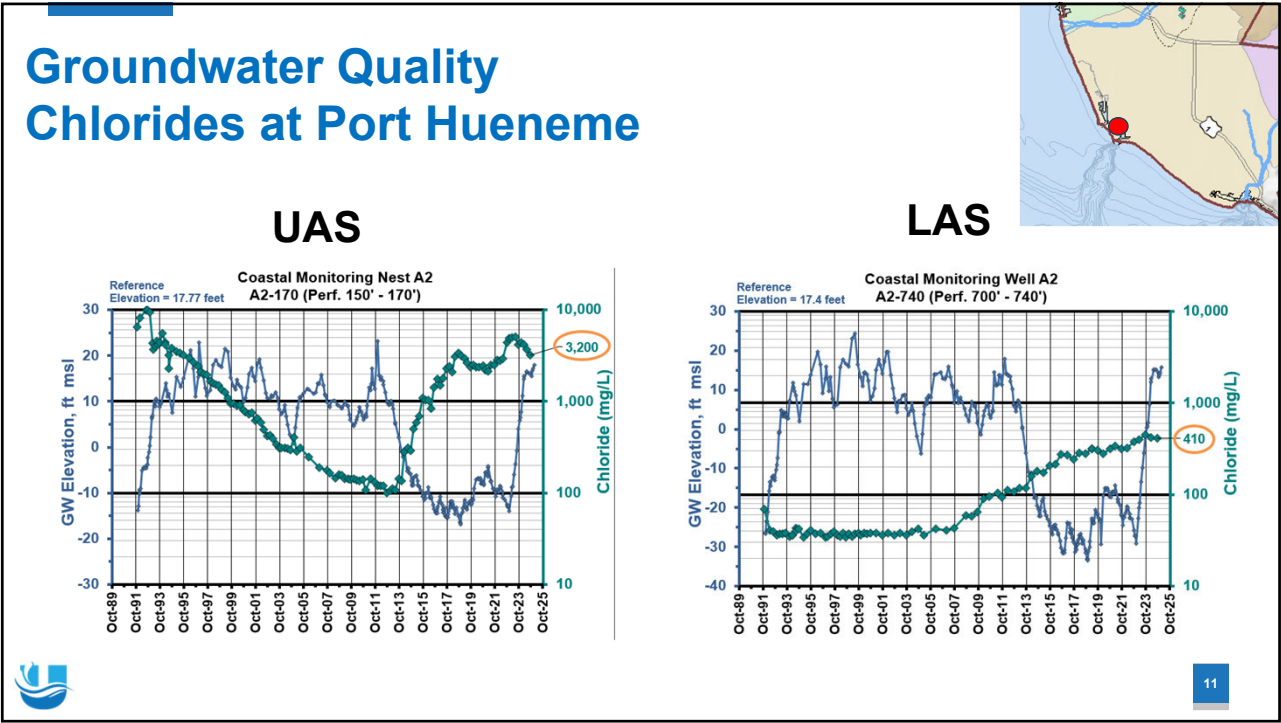


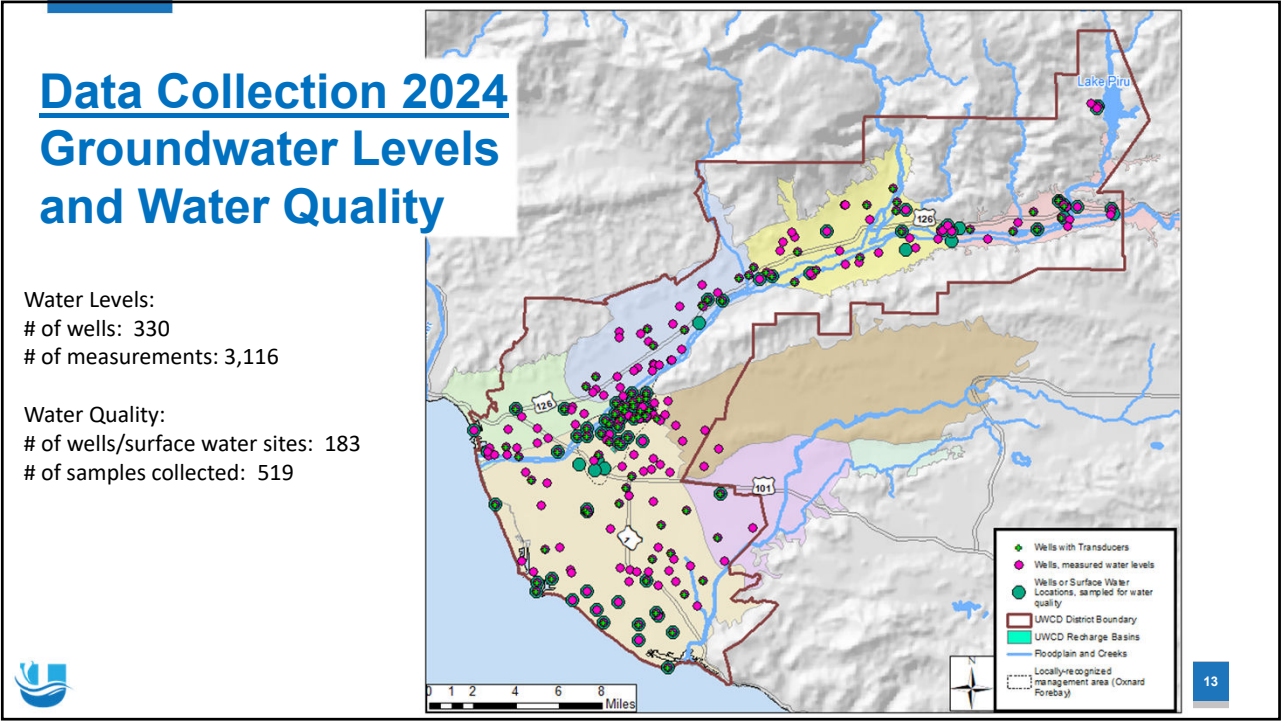

Groundwater Quality – Nitrates in Forebay

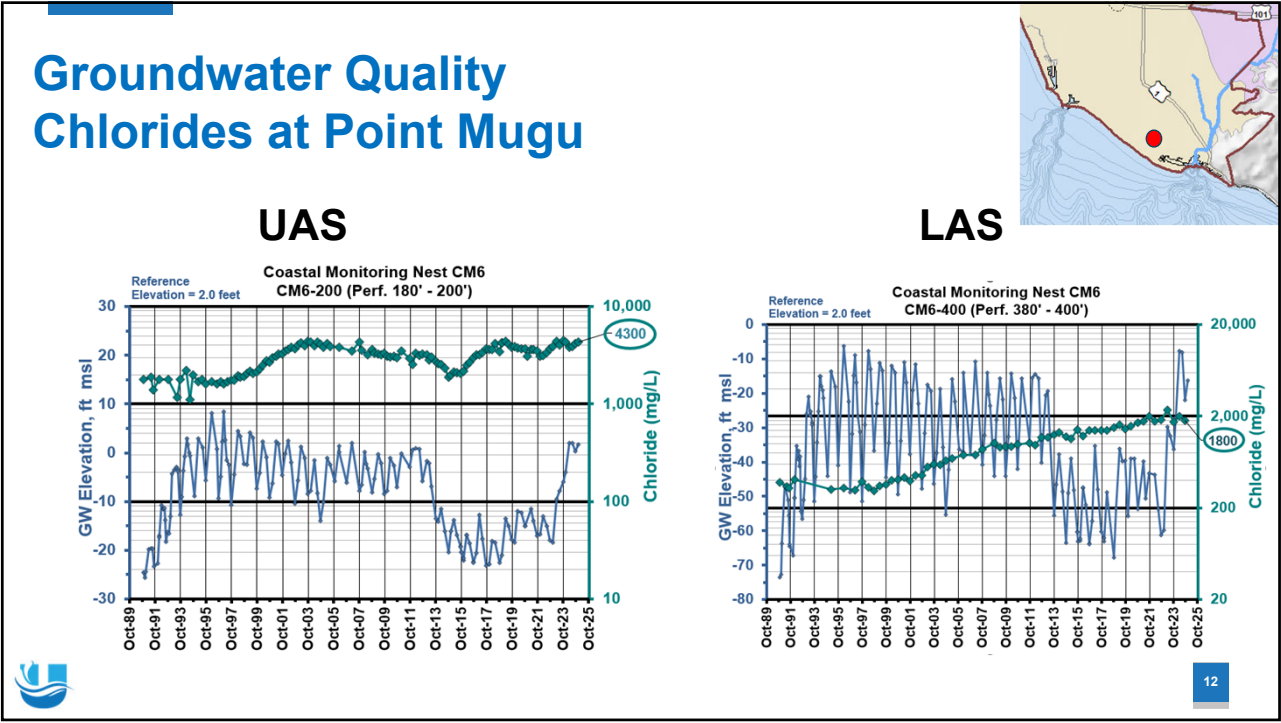
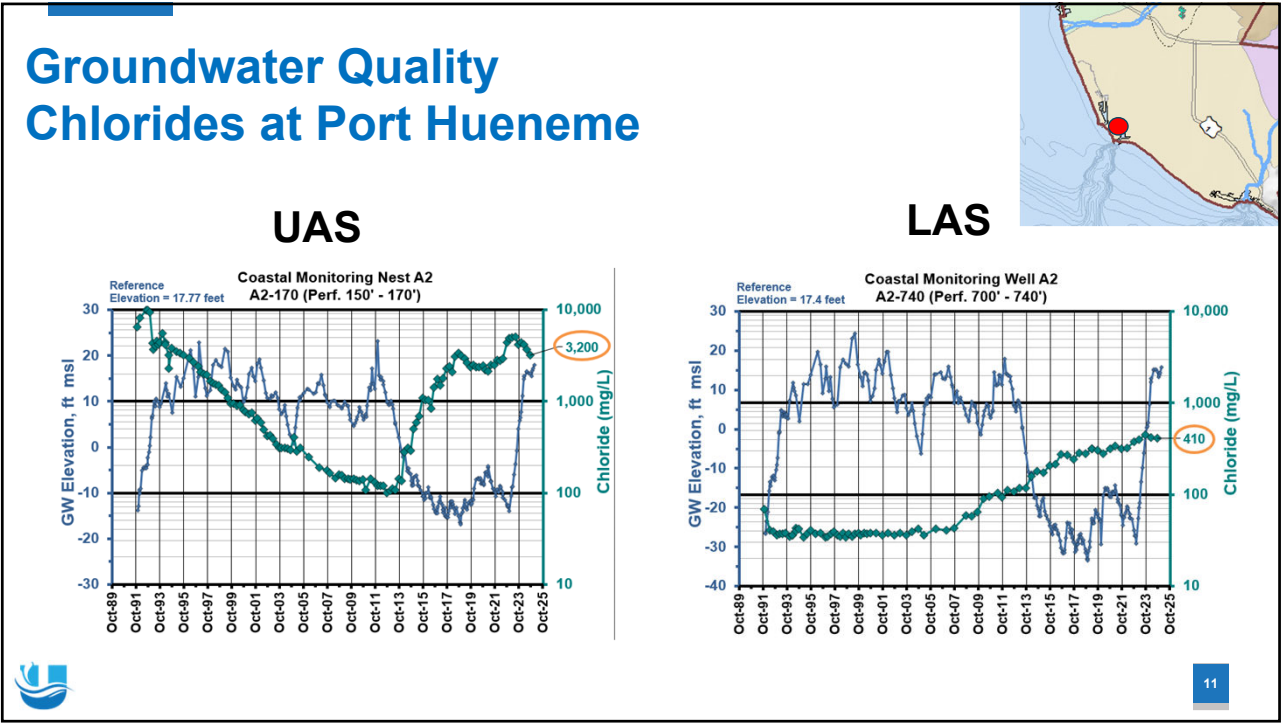


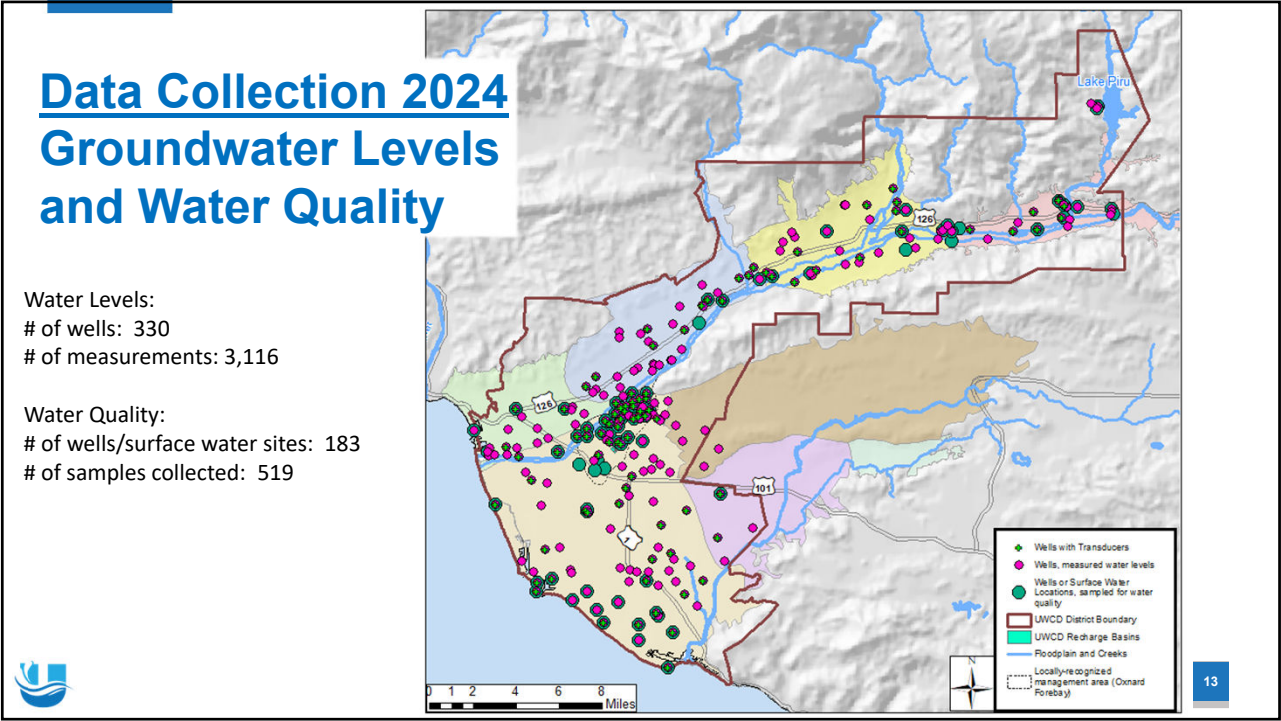
