



Lake Piru Recreation Area Filming Requirements & Rate Sheet

Location Fees

Cinema/Feature Film/Television Series Productions/Television Commercial/Infomercial/Public Service Announcements/Music Videos:

Large commercial film shoots/productions will be charged a minimum fee of \$1,000 per day (and up), plus applicable service fees. Rates and fees will be based on the use of facilities, impact to those facilities and the public, size of operation, and the complexity of production.

Still Photography:

All still photography shoots will be charged a minimum fee of \$500.00 per day (and up), plus applicable Service fees. Rates and fees will be based on the use of facilities, impact to those facilities and the public, size of operation, and the complexity of production.

Student Film Productions:

All student film shoots and film projects will be charged a minimum fee of \$250.00 per day (and up), plus applicable service fees. Rates and fees will be based on the use of facilities, impact to those facilities and the public, size of operation, and the complexity of production.

Service Fees:

Depending on the size, location and activity involved, applicant may be required to pay for District staff to be present. It should be noted that all water based film shoots will be required to pay for a minimum of one District staff member.

\$51.47 hr. & up, Ranger for land based activities
\$120/hr. (flat rate), Ranger for water based activities

Clean-up/Damage Fees:

Licensee is required to cleanup any debris and leave the premises in same or better condition as when the licensee arrived. If the licensee fails to perform necessary cleanup to bring premise to its pre-existing state, the District may perform the cleanup and charge licensee an hourly fee of \$50.00 for the District

time. If licensee damages premises, licensee will be charged the District's actual cost to repair or replace damaged premise.

Operations Impact Fee :

Filming agencies may be required to pay additional fees to the onsite Concessions Service. These rates will be determined by the use of facility, impact to public, size of operation, complexity of production, the location of the shoot and the impact on the concession services business operations. These fees will be determined United Water Conservation District Film Permit advisor after coordination and agreement with the onsite concessions service manager and will be based on the above-mentioned criteria.

Insurance Requirements

Agencies filming within the boundaries of the Lake Piru recreation Area will not be issued a permit until such a time that United Water Conservation District, their officers, employees, volunteers, elected officials and members of boards and commissions are named as ADDITIONAL INSUREDs of an insurance policy having a minimum coverage at all times of \$1 million General Liability and \$1 million for Property Damage. Said insurance shall apply as primary insurance and no other insurance maintained by the Additional Insured will be called upon to contribute with insurance provided by this policy. The policy must state "United Water Conservation District must be provided 30 days advance written notice of any change in coverage or cancellation". Any exceptions to the above must be approved in writing by the United Water Conservation District Chief Park Ranger.

***** Please note an insurance certificate must be accompanied by an insurance endorsement naming United Water Conservation District as additionally insured. This endorsement shall accompany the said insured's certificate of insurance which shall also name UWCD as additionally insured.***

Permit/Application/Contract Requirements:

All agencies filming within the Lake Piru Recreation Area will be required to provide a copy of a completed Ventura County Film Permit. The Ventura County Film permit Office can be contacted at (805) 654-2488. Agencies will also be required to provide a “wet signature” copy of the above provided -Lake Piru Recreation Area Film Contract Agreement.

Document Deadlines:

All documents must be received no later than three (3) business days prior to the shoot date. Documents received later than this time will be charged \$100.00 late processing fee.

All rates are subject to change. The Chief Park Ranger of United Water Conservation District reserves the right to increase or decrease fees based upon the use of facility, impact to public, size of operation, complexity of production and the location of the shoot.
